“Keep the Wreath Red” Holiday Fire Safety Campaign Comes to a Close

Clay Township, IN – On November 26, 2015, Clay Fire kicked off the 6th annual “Keep the Wreath Red” holiday fire safety campaign. The large wreath lit with red bulbs was displayed at Clay Station 21 on Cleveland Road in Clay Township. During the 37-day event, five red bulbs were changed to white representing a fire that occurred over the holiday season that could have been prevented. This was an increase from 2014 by two. The five preventable fires during this holiday fire safety campaign were caused by a stove and oven fire, space heater, candle and a chimney fire.
