Fire Damages Two Residential Properties in Granger

Granger, IN – The Clay Fire Territory responded to a reported residential fire located in the 12000 block of Campfire Drive in Granger shortly after 5:00 PM today. Fire crews arrived on the scene within 2-minutes and 35-seconds of being dispatched to the fire. The fire department quickly located a significant working fire in the attached garage of the home. The intense heat and flames from the fire was enough to melt the vinyl siding on a neighboring residential structure. The occupants/homeowners affected by today's fire were able to safely exit the building. There were no reports of civilian injuries.

The fire was quickly brought under control within minutes of the first arriving units. Damages to the building of fire origin are significant, including a total loss of the attached garage. Two firefighters from Clay Fire sustained minor, non-life threatening injuries. Both firefighters were treated and released at a local hospital.

The Clay Fire Territory recommends to always have properly functioning smoke detectors, and to practice exit drills in the home.

As part of a typical fire response, fire crews from more than six (6) different area fire departments were called to assist with the blaze. Firefighters remained on the scene for several hours to ensure spot fires were controlled.
