Public Display of Fireworks- Required Information for Permit Request

- Provide all required IDHS application information
- Provide verification that the amount and size of fireworks confirm with site requirements as identified in NFPA 1123
- Identify how on-stage storage will be provided
- When appropriate, provide letters of support from adjacent properties
- Identify the specific pyrotechnic operations who will be conducting the display
- Provide specific resume, including certification and qualifications for the specific pyrotechnic operations conducting the display
- Provide a written statement from the applicant company requesting to perform the display of the following:
 - The exhibit will be conducted in compliance with all aspects of NFPA 1123
 - The operations are properly qualified per NFPA 1123, and understand the requirements of NFPA 1123
 - Only fireworks approved as part of this permit will be discharged
 - All operators, shooters, assistants and monitors will not participate in the consumption of any alcoholic beverages or be under the influence of any drugs that are not over-the-counter or prescribed medications used in compliance with the manufacturer or physicians written instructions, as outlined in NFPA 1123- Section 8.1.9
- Identify how the requirements identified in NFPA 1123 Chapter 8: Operations of the Display will be addressed
- Identify how fire suppression capabilities will be provided (NFPA 1123-Section 8.1.1)
- Provide a detailed emergency plan, including procedures for the following:
 - Communications
 - Weather monitoring
 - Site Security
 - Emergency forces notifications
 - Emergency medical services
 - Emergency vehicle staging and access routes
- Provide event attendance estimates
- Identify how security will be provided before and during the display
- Identify how the shooting area will be secured before and during the display
- Identify how crowd control will be managed and maintained during the display
- Identify where vehicles will be parked
- Provide a certificate of insurance, listing Clay Fire Territory as an additional insured, for an amount not less than \$100,000 for all damages which may be caused either to a person or persons, and to any property
