

TRAINING DIVISION

2020 was a busy year for the Training Division. In 2020, members of **CLAY FIRE** completed **28,590 hours of training**. The highlights of that training include:



- **Fire Training:** 9,209 hours
- **EMS Training:** 5,723 hours
- **Driver Training:** 5,624 hours
- **Officer Training:** 2,022 hours

The following certification classes were offered in 2020:

- **Fire Officer II**
- **Fire Officer III**
- **Instructor II/III**
- **Firefighter I/II**
- **EMT-Basic**

- 14 individuals are currently attending Recruit Academy Class 18
- 4 members continued to pursue the Executive Fire Officer (EFO) designation through the National Fire Academy



Lastly, **CLAY FIRE** was awarded a **\$7,000** infrastructure grant which will be used for a training tower expansion that will be completed in 2021.

In 2020, **CLAY FIRE** was awarded a Staffing for Adequate Fire & Emergency Response (SAFER) through FEMA. The grant award was **\$2,110,050** and will allow for the hiring of **9** additional career firefighters. The new firefighters are expected to be hired in the spring of 2021.
